THEN - AND - NOW Edelweiss Village in Golden

In the Swiss Herald from May/June 2021 I posted an article about the famous Swiss Mountain guides who immigrated to Canada and guided lots of people on top of the highest peaks of the Rocky Mountains.

Some of them brought their families and a few houses were built for them near Golden. They called it the Edelweiss Village.

It was eventually abandoned and stayed empty for quite a few years. Then it was for sale.

For \$2.3 million you can buy an entire village of Swiss chalets, nestled in the Rockies
The historic Golden, B.C., property offers mountain vistas at every turn and has been sitting on the market for 600 days and counting No one currently lives in Edelweiss Village in Golden, B.C., but don't call it abandoned. The property's owners—descendants of the Swiss mountain guides who first lived in the community—still tend to the plants almost every day, despite this unique property being up

for sale for nearly two years now.

The original six historic homes on the 50-acre plot were built by the Canadian Pacific Railway in the early 1910s, and a seventh was added in 1978. Now, the entire village, nestled between the Selkirk, Purcell and Rocky mountains, is up for sale.

"A lot of people are looking and saying they can make some pretty awesome Airbnbs," says realtor Eddie Leigan. "Others are saying each member of their family can have their own house.

Initial Concerns and Preservation Efforts:

Edelweiss Village, a historic village of Swiss-style chalets built for mountain guides, was facing potential demolition and a lack of heritage protection. The village, located north of Golden in a rural area without heritage laws, was up for sale for \$2.3 million. A group called the Swiss Edelweiss Village Foundation was formed to raise awareness and explore ways to save the village, with hopes of buying it.

• Montayne's Purchase and Transformation:

In July 2023, Montayne, a real estate consulting firm, purchased the site. Montayne, along with the Swiss Edelweiss Village Foundation, began renovating the chalets and implementing plans to preserve the historical significance of the village.

Future Plans and Opening:

The first phase of the project, including the opening of the renovated chalets for accommodation, is starting soon. Further phases plan to add a spa, thermal pools, eco pods, and the Swiss Guides Great Hall, a multi-purpose space for cultural exhibits, community gatherings, and events. The resort aims to be a living museum, celebrating the legacy of the Swiss mountain guides and their contributions to Canadian mountaineering.

• Collaboration and Community Involvement:

Montayne is working closely with the Swiss Edelweiss Village Foundation and the local community to ensure the village's historical significance is preserved and celebrated. Montayne also recognizes the importance of the village for the local community and the Swiss living abroad in Canada, according to swissinfo.ch.


